1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- **1.2** Appendix P will be applied.
- **1.3** Korea Sailing Federation's regulation shall be applied.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats shall be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Optimist Class. (1 Class, 6 category)

- 3.2 All participants must be registered to KSAF 2016 athlete registration system.
- **3.3** Foreign participants are exempt from clause 3.2 above.
- a) Late entries will be accepted under the rule of organizing authority.
- b) Entries shall be made by 20 Apr 2016.
- c) All participants who have submitted entries shall register for the regatta and measurement at the Race office by 18:00 12 May 2016.
- Each country may enter up to 3 participants & 1 official.

8 THE COURSES

The course for the racing will be trapezoid course or windward, leeward course.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1 The Scoring Penalty, rule 44.1 & 44.2, will apply.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 ISAF RRS Appendix A(Low Point System) will be applied.
- 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be total of her score excluding her worst score.
- 10.3 No group is divided for the start.

11 SUPPORT BOATS

All official boats must display the flag provided by organizing authority.

Only race officials can go on the board of official boats. (Except foreign participants)

12 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the harbour.

13 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15 PRIZES

Prize medal and award certificate to be given to participants in 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each category.

- 15.2 If prize winner did not come to award ceremony without proper reported reason, all prize (trophy, medal, certificate, prize money) will be withdrawn.
- 15.3 All participants must attend opening & award ceremony. (Teams not attending these ceremonies will be not eligible for free transportation of boats)

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17 SAFETY

Each participant must sign in & sign out before and after sailing. A breach of this clause will cause 2 points of penalty to the race.

18 SUPPORT

18.1 Organizing Committee will support accommodation, meals, & local equipment transportation during the regatta

Designated transportation agencies by the Organizing Committee will provide transportation of boats.

Foreign Participants' all boat equipment will be chartered, except sail and rig. Accommodation, meals, and transportation from/to Yeosu Airport to/from hotel will be provided. (Airfare is not supported)
