NOTICE OF RACE

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NOR means that the penalty for breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the international jury or protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence. This changes RRS 63.7
- 1.5 Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.2 Other documents governing the regatta will be published on the ONB.
- 3.3 [DP] From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to boats in the following classes:
 - Optimist
 - ILCA4
 - ILCA6 Youth U19
 - 420 Class Youth U19
- 4.2 Optimist competitors shall have been born in 2009 or later.
- 4.3 ILCA4 competitors shall have been born in 2007 or later.
- 4.4 ILCA6 competitors shall have been born in 2006 or later.



- 4.5 420 U19 competitors shall have been born in 2006 or later.
- 4.6 Fleet may be combined depending on entries.
- 4.7 Eligible boats must enter by complete entry forms electronically at <https://forms.fillout.com/t/gAjddyHkaWus> by 23.59 of 13 October 2024.
- 4.8 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organizing authority.
- 4.9 To complete the entry process, sailors are required to register on site at the Royal Varuna Yacht Club from 09.30-16.00 on Thursday 17 October 2024.

8. VENUE

8.1 Racing will take place in the water immediately off the Royal Varuna Yacht Club.

8.2 Visitor parking is limited. Visitors are requested to follow instruction of RVYC's security guards about to parking.

9. Courses

9.1 The courses to be sailed will be of the IODA trapezoid for Optimist and Trapezoid or Windward/Leeward configuration for other classes.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 Appendix P will apply.

11. SCORING

11.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.2 There will be a maximum of 12 races in the series.

11.3 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. (b) When 5 races or more have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12. SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

12.1 It is mandatory for support coats to carry at least on VHF radio on board.

12.2 All persons aboard support boat shall wear buoyancy aids at all time while they are afloat.
