1. DATE & VENUE

The 40th MSA-NSC-MILO National Open Championship 2026 will be held from 21-26 December 2026 at the Timah Tasoh Lake, Perlis, Malaysia.

2. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The regatta is organized by the Malaysia Sailing Association (MSA) and Perlis Sailing Association (PSA) with the Ministry of Youth and Sports. And Ministry of Education under the auspices of the National Sport Council (MSN).

3. ENTRY

The regatta will be open to both national (Malaysian) and international participants.

4. CLASSES

- i. ILCA 7
- ii. ILCA 6 MEN/WOMEN
- iii. ILCA 4 Boys & Girls born in 2009 or after.
- iv. International 470 Mix Open
- v. Optimist (under 16) for individuals born in 2011 or later.
- vi. Optimist Junior Under 12 born in 2014 or after; Junior Under 10 born in 2016 or after.
- vii. Optimist Team Race (Top 16 teams only)
- viii. International 420 Open (Under 21) Girls & Boys born in 2006 or later.
- ix. Windsurfing Bic Techno Men/Women (under 17) born in 2009 or later.
- x. 29ER - Open
- xi. Big Techno Plus - Open

***(Provided there is a minimum of 5 entries in each category)**

5. RULES

- 5.1 The regatta will be governed by RRS 2025- 2028 WS Racing Rules of Sailing. (RRS), the class rules, the notice of race, and the sailing instructions
- 5.2 National prescriptions, if any, will apply.
- 5.3 In all rules governing this event, the notations:
 - 5.3.1 [DP] in a rule means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee results in a penalty that is less severe than disqualification.
 - 5.3.2 [SP] denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the race committee without a hearing or a discretionary penalty applied by the protest Committee with a hearing. This changes RRS 60.5(b)(1) and A5.
 - 5.3.3 [NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. These changes RRS 60.1
- 5.4 In case of a conflict between languages, the English text will be considered authoritative.
- 5.5 The Equipment Rules of Sailing will apply.

6. EVENT ADVERTISING

- 6.1 Competitor advertising will be restricted to World Sailing Regulation 20, Advertising Code.

- 6.2 [DP] Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

7. MEASUREMENT

- 7.1 Except for boats that are supplied by the organizing authority, each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.
- 7.2 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved in writing by the technical committee. Requests for substitutions shall be made to the technical committee at the first reasonable opportunity by filling in a relevant form at the Race Office. The substitution may only be permitted after the technical committee has checked and scrutinized both the damaged and the substitute equipment.
- 7.3 If the substitution was made on the water before or between races, both the damaged and the substituted equipment shall be presented to the technical committee after the end of the day's racing. Repairs or replacements required afloat may be approved after the race, provided that either the race committee or the technical committee afloat is notified before the next race.
- 7.4 Once a boat has completed measurements, the hull may not be removed from the boat park without the permission of the race committee.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1 RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for RRS 42, will apply.
- 8.2 For the 29er class, RRS 44.1 and RRS P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9. JURY

The International Jury will be appointed by the organizer and will act in accordance with RRS 70.3 and Appendix N. Decisions of the jury are final and not subject to appeal.

10. [DP] SUPPORT VESSELS

Team support vessels shall be registered with the Organizing Authority and used according to the following conditions.

- 10.1 Support vessels shall clearly display a flag with their club or country name or shall be permanently marked with a sticker with their club or country name, clearly visible from both sides of the vessel or engine. The minimum height for the letters shall be 200mm. No other flags or identification shall be displayed by support vessels.
- 10.2 Fuel and other consumables shall be paid for by the teams using the vessel.
- 10.3 Personnel on board support vessels are required to wear a life jacket or personal flotation device while on the water and to hold a certified powerboat certificate from MSA or from their own country.
- 10.4 All coaches, managers, and team support personnel must register.

11. ENTRIES & FEES

Entrance fees are RM420.00/per participant for the Optimist Class and RM500.00/per participant for other classes registered before 01 Dec 2026. Late registration after 01 Dec 2026, entry fees will be RM500.00/Per participant for the Optimist Class and RM600.00/Per participant for other classes. All local sailors (Malaysian) will pay for the Optimist Class and RM150.00/per participant for other classes RM180.00, registered before 01 Dec 2026. Late registration after 1 Dec 2026, entry fees will be RM180.00/Per participant for the Optimist Class and RM200.00/Per participant for other classes. The entry fee includes breakfast, lunch, closing dinner, and a T-shirt. Payment made to Perlis Sailing Association as below:

21. **Single-use water bottles and packed food in plastic containers.**

- 21.1 All competitors and officials are requested not to bring 'single Use' plastic bottles, plastic food containers, or any plastic to the venue and racing area on water.
- 21.2 Please bring your own refillable water containers.
- 21.3 Water will be available at the venue from water dispensers.

22. **COVID 19 MITIGATION REQUIREMENT**

- 22.1 All participants, team leaders, coaches, and support staff shall adhere to the event COVID 19 protocol as published.
- 22.2 All participants, team leaders, coaches, and support staff must register with the Organizing Authority to obtain accreditation to access the venue.
- 22.3 Accreditation to enter the venue may be revoked by the Organizing Authority if a Person is found breaching the following requirement:

- (a) Persons attending the event shall observe a physical distance of at least 1meter.

(b) Persons attending the event advise wear a properly fitted, suitable face mask while ashore at the venue.

- 22.4 Persons who display suspected symptoms, as determined by a doctor appointed by the OA against the Event COVID19 Protocol, or who test positive for Covid 19 may be excluded from accessing the venue and shall be reported to the local health authorities.
