1. DATE & VENUE

The 5TH **LANGKAWI YOUTH SAILING CHAMPIONSHIP 2026 (MALAYSIA NATIONAL YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP)** will be held from 24-28 JUNE 2025 at the National Sailing Centre, Langkawi, Kedah, Malaysia.

2. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The regatta is organized by Malaysia Sailing Association and Kedah Sailing Association with Ministry of youth and sports and Ministry of Education under auspices of National Sport Council and Malaysian Sailing Association (MSA)

3. ENTRY - The regatta will be open to both national (Malaysian) and international participants.

4. CLASSES

- (i) ILCA 7 (Under 21 born in 2005 or later)
- (ii) ILCA 6 MEN/WOMEN (Under 21 born in 2005 or later)
- (iii) ILCA 4.7 (Under 17) Boys & Girls Born 2009 or later
- (iv) Optimist (under 16) Born in 2011 or later
- (v) International 420 Open (Under 21) Girls & Boys Born in 2005 or later
- (vi) Wing Foil X -15 , Wing Foil (Under 21 Born in 2005 or Later)
- (vii) Windsurfing Bic Techno Men/Women (Under 17) Born in 2009 or later
- (viii) Windsurfing Bic Techno Plus Men/Women (Under 17) Born in 2009 or later
- (ix) 29ER - OPEN Under 21 born in 2005 or later

**(Provided there is a minimum of 5 entries in each category)*

5. RULES

- 5.1 The regatta will be governed by the RRS 2024- 2028 ISAF RACING Racing Rules OF SAILING (RRS), the Class Rules, the Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 5.2 National prescriptions if any will apply.
- 5.3 In all rules governing this event, THE NOTATIONS;
 - 5.3.1 [DP] in a rule means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.
 - 5.3.2 [SP] denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the race committee without a hearing or a discretionary penalty applied by the protest committee with a hearing. THIS CHANGES RRS 63.1 and A5.
 - 5.3.3 [NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. These changes. RRS 60.1(a)
- 5.4 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.
- 5.5 The Equipment Rules of Sailing will apply.

6 EVENT ADVERTISING.

- 6.1 Competitor advertising will be restricted to World Sailing Regulation 20 Advertising.
- 6.2 [DP] Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

7 MEASUREMENTS

- 7.1 Except for boats that are supplied by the organizing authority, each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.
- 7.2 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved in writing by the technical committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the technical committee at the first reasonable opportunity by filling in a relevant form at the Race Office. The substitution may only be permitted after the technical committee has checked and scrutinized both the damaged and the substituting equipment.
- 7.3 If the substitution was made on the water before or between races, both the damaged and the equipment substituted shall be presented to the technical committee after the end of the day's racing. Repairs or replacements required afloat may be approved after the race provided that either the race committee or the technical committee afloat is notified before the next race.
- 7.4 Once a boat has completed measurements, the hull may not be removed from the boat park without the permission of the race committee.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1 RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for RRS 42, will apply.
- 8.2 For the 29er class, RRS 44.1 and RRS P2.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9. JURY

International Jury will be appointed by the organizer and will act accordance with RRS 70.5 and appendixes N. Decision of juries are final and not subject to appeal

10. [DP] SUPPORT VESSELS

Team support vessels shall be registered with the organizing Authority and used according to the following conditions.

- 10.1 Support vessels shall clearly display a flag with their club or country name or shall be permanently marked with a sticker with their club or country name, clearly visible from both sides of the vessel or engine. The minimum height for the letters shall be 200mm. No other flags or identification shall be displayed by support vessels.
- 10.2 Fuel and other consumables shall be paid for by the teams using the vessel.
- 10.3 Personnel on board support vessels are required to wear a life jacket or personal flotation device while on the water and to be a certified powerboat certificate holder from MSA or from their own country.
- 10.4 All coaches, managers, and team support personnel must register.**

11. ENTRIES & FEES

Entrance fees are **RM420.00/per participant for the Optimist Class** and **RM520.00/per participant for other classes** registered before 01Jun 2026. Late registration after 01 Jun 2026 Entry Fees will be RM500.00/Per participant for the Optimist Class and RM600.00/Per participant for other classes. All local sailors (Malaysian) will pay for the Optimist Class and RM180.00/per participant for other classes RM200.00, registered before 01June 2026. Late registration after 01 June 2026, Entry Fees will be RM200.00/Per participant for the Optimist Class and RM250.00/Per participant for other classes. Entry fee includes breakfast and lunch.

21. Single-use water bottles and packed food in plastic containers.
- 21.1 All competitors and officials are requested not to bring 'single Use' plastic bottles, plastic food containers, or any plastic to the venue and racing area on the water.

- 21.2 Please bring your own refillable water containers.
- 21.3 Water will be available at the venue from water dispensers.

22. COVID 19 MITIGATION REQUIREMENT

- 22.1 All participants, team leaders, coaches, and support staff shall adhere to the event COVID 19 Protocol as published.
- 22.2 All participants, team leaders, coaches, and support staff must register with the Organizing Authority to obtain accreditation to access the venue.
- 22.3 Accreditation to enter the venue may be revoked by the Organizing Authority if a person is found breaching the following requirement:
 - (a) Persons attending the event shall observe a physical distance from others of at least 1 meter.
 - (b) Persons attending the event advise wear a properly fitted, suitable face mask while on-site at the venue.
- 22.4 Persons who display suspected symptoms, as determined by a doctor appointed by the OA against the Event COVID19 Protocol, or who test positive for Covid 19 may be excluded from accessing the venue and shall be reported to the local health authorities.
- 22.5 It is the responsibility of the participant to report any suspected symptoms, commit to self-isolation, and follow the instructions of the local health authorities until a Covid 19 PCR swab test produces a negative result.
